GUEST PREACHERS THIS TERM



Fr. Phil Ritchie—10th Nov (wk 5)

Fr. Phil has been Vicar at St Mary's Primrose Hill since Advent 2023, before this he was a priest here in Oxford. He is passionate about the life of the local church in all its variety especially our worship and prayer life together and our commitment to social justice. Phil is a novice tertiary Franciscan and a member of the Sodality of Mary Mother of Priests.

The Rev'd Helena Bickley-Percival—17th Nov (wk 6)

The Revd Helena Bickley-Percival is Minor Canon and Chaplain at Westminster Abbey, involved in planning liturgy, and in pastoral care. She studied music at Oxford, where she sang in the Choir of The Queen's College, and later at Royal Holloway. Her interests include the movement for the ordination of women in the early 20th century and the interaction between live and broadcast performance.





The Rev'd Molly Boot—24th Nov (wk 7) Choral Eucharist for Christ the King

Molly is a theologian, musician and priest, currently based in rural Gloucestershire. They're very enthusiastic about music, prayer, LGBTQ+ liberation, and medieval church history. They are a trustee of the Greenbelt Festival and the British Trust for Tantur, a charity supporting study at an ecumenical institute between Jerusalem and Bethlehem.

The Rev'd Alice Watson is the Chaplain, and a member of the welfare team.

She is always happy to meet college members for pastoral reasons, or to discuss faith and spirituality, or just for a chat or a walk.

Alice is an Anglican priest, but she's here for everyone in college, regardless of faith or background.
